Hoffman Haus Notes

1-All knives have a limited warranty against breakage and damage. The limit of the warranty is misuse as spelled out in the "Knife care section". To say again: Any thing outside the designed use that causes damage of that knife will not be warranted! Natural handle material such as Bone, Antler, Wood, Ivory, unless stabilized, will possibly shrink, expand or crack, Etc. Handles need to be cleaned, wax, oiled frequently, just as the blades do.

Note: Hoffman Haus Knives reserves the right to determine what constitutes misuse of a knife.

2-All knives or hatchets have a lifetime free (you provide postage & insurance to and from) sharpening service.

3- All the high carbon steel knives and hatchets are torch heated, and oil hardened to a glass like hardness. The blades then have their temper drawn back in a tempering oven to a proper hardness for the design uses of that knife or hatchet. As I don't have a hardness tester I use the color of the steel, that comes from a specific temperature, as a gage for the proper hardness.

Note: Unless noted all the blades are made from 10 series high carbon steel

Note: From 2010 until further notice, All knives and hatchets will be made from 5160 Spring Steel.

4-All sheaths have triple leather at the seams and are hand sown, riveted, or a combination of both. All seams are glued. The leather used is oak tanned, and is 5-6oz or 8-9oz shoulder leather.

5- Art work done on bone, antler, horn, ivory, etc. are natural materials and will expand, contract, crack, etc. Proper care of these items is given in the art work care section. With proper care you will eliminate most if not all damage caused by time.
